On February 25, 2015, South Carolina Electric & Gas Company (SCE&G), acting for
itself and as an agent for South Carolina Public Service Authority, submitted a relief
request for a dissimilar metal weld categorization change per the referenced letter.
After a conference call with the NRC staff on April 7, 2015, SCE&G has decided to
withdraw the proposed relief request. The relief request will be resubmitted when the
EPRI sponsored Alloy 690/52/152 Expert Panel has developed a recommendation for a
new Alloy 152 crack growth rate curve and improvement factor for primary water stress
corrosion cracking.
