Dear Mark:

By this letter, Strata Energy, Inc. (Strata), a United States-based, wholly-owned subsidiary of Peninsula Energy, Ltd. (Peninsula) submits this application to the Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality-Land Quality Division (LQD) Staff requesting authorization to amend Permit No. 802 to include the lands within the Kendrick Expansion Area (KEA).

As you well know, Strata Energy has been working closely with LQD in development of the enclosed permit amendment application. I believe these interactions have been beneficial for both groups and led to the establishment of fundamental relationships essential to the current regulatory framework. With this in mind, several key items should be noted:

- This transmittal includes two (2) bound copies of the insertion and replacement pages for the Adjudication File, Appendix D Baseline Documents, Mine Plan and Reclamation Plan.
- Volume 1 of the amendment package includes an Index of Change to guide page replacement and insertion.
- Appendix D3, Addendum D3-2, which includes the Class III Cultural and Paleontological Resources Inventory, is being provided on CD due the size and confidential nature of the materials.
- Appendix D6, Addendum D6-11, which includes laboratory data sheets and field sampling forms, is being provided on CD due to the size. This CD also includes the water quality/quantity data in the LQD's spreadsheet format.
- Addendum MP-2 of the Mine Plan includes the site hydrological model and the associated MODFLOW/GW Vistas files for use by your staff.

Strata appreciates the opportunity to submit the permit amendment application, and looks forward to working with LQD Staff in the near future to ensure that Strata's

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requested permit amendment as issued is adequately protective of public health and safety and the environment.
