Alonso & Carus Iron Works, Inc. (A&C) announced last week that it has filed a voluntary petition for Chapter 11 reorganization in the U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the District of Puerto Rico. A&C took this action in order to achieve a cost and debt structure that is industry competitive and thereby assure its long-term viability and ability to continue delivering top quality structural steel and tank products for its customers.

The Board of Directors determined that a Chapter 11 reorganization is in the best interest of A&C. The Chapter 11 process enables A&C to continue conducting normal business operations while they restructure their debt, costs and other obligations.

All divisions of A&C (i.e., structures, tanks, NDE, architectural metal panels, and industrial technical services) are conducting business as usual. Likewise, throughout the Chapter 11 process, A&C expects to continue to: 1) Provide employee wages, healthcare coverage, and other benefits, without interruption; and 2) Pay suppliers for goods and services received during the reorganization process.
