On April 9–11, 2015, during the 623rd meeting of the Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards (the Committee), the Committee completed its review of the General Electric-Hitachi (GEH) topical report NEDE-33766P, "GEH Simplified Stability Solution (GS3)," as well as the final safety evaluation prepared by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff. The Committee concurred with the NRC staff's finding that topical report NEDE-33766P, documenting the GEH Simplified Stability Solution, is acceptable for boiling water reactor/2-6 licensing applications to the extent specified and under the limitations and conditions delineated in the topical report and in the staff's safety evaluation.
