SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REGARDING LUMONDI INC  
EXEMPT DISTRIBUTION LICENSE RENEWAL APPLICATION

Dear Mr. Robertson:

This letter refers to your application dated March 16, 2015, Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) Accession No. ML15086A179, for your renewal of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Exempt-Distribution Materials License no. 04-23929-01E. In reviewing your application, we have determined additional information is required to complete our review.

The intention of this request is to have an up-to-date document that provides all of the information required by the regulations in 10 CFR 32.14, "Certain items containing byproduct material; requirements for license to apply or initially transfer," and described in the relevant guidance document NUREG-1556 Volume 8 titled "Program-Specific Guidance about Exempt Distribution Licenses." It is acceptable to reuse previously submitted documents as long as they are provided as attachments to a new document describing your current program. The new document should provide the answers to each of the requested information listed below, either as a statement within the new document itself, or by referring to an attached, previously-submitted document. Please provide the following information:

1. Please provide the model numbers you will be distributing under your exempt distribution license no. 04-23923-01E and the maximum quantity of byproduct material in each model as required by 10 CFR 32.14(b)(1).
2. As required by 10 CFR 32.14(b)(2) please provide a detail description of the construction and design of each product.
3. As required by 10 CFR 32.14(b)(3) please provide the method of containment or binding of the byproduct material in the product.
4. As required by 10 CFR 32.14(b)(6) please provide the proposed method of labeling or marking the container with the identification of the manufacturer or initial transferor of the product and the byproduct material in the product.

Any correspondence regarding your application should reference the control number specified below. Please submit the requested information within 30 days of the date of this letter. If we have not received complete information within 30 days of the date of this letter, we will assume that you do not wish to pursue your application, and we will take regulatory action to your current NRC License, 04-23929-01E.

Please be aware that you may request that certain portions of your submittal to NRC be withheld from public disclosure as proprietary information. To do this, you must execute an affidavit as specified in 10 CFR 2.390, "Public inspections, exemptions, requests for withholding." You must list all portions that you wish to be held proprietary, along with your reasoning as to why that is appropriate. While it is allowable, please refrain from submitting proprietary information in support of a license unless necessary. Keep in mind that all NRC licenses are considered to be in the public domain, and therefore may be viewed by any member of the public who requests to see them.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 a copy of this letter will be available electronically for public inspection in NRC's Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records (PARS) component of NRC's document system (ADAMS). ADAMS is accessible from the NRC web site at <http://www.nrc.gov/NRC/ADAMS/index.html> (the Public Electronic Reading Room).
