

Dear Ms. Bladey:

I object to Florida Power and Light's plan to expand Nuclear Power Generation at Turkey Point. Contrary to the assertion of the NRC (EIS) that the "socioeconomic " effects of building and operating the proposed reactors #6 and #7, are "small and beneficial" I believe the actual risk to the population of South Florida is astronomical and potentially devastating. History has shown that unanticipated "incidents" can occur at Nuclear Power generating facilities. History has also shown that the results of such an incident can be catastrophic and long lasting. Locating a Nuclear Power Generating Facility in close proximity to a densely populated metropolitan area of more than 2,500,000 people, is an ill conceived notion at best. Although this decision may be a means to enrich the shareholders of FP&L, it places the entire population of South Florida in extreme jeopardy. I simply am not willing to take the necessary personal and financial risk to further FP&L's business objectives. I hereby request that you deny the construction and operating license for the proposed facilities at Turkey Point.
