Dear Dr. Kolodziej:

This refers to the licenses listed above. Because mail is no longer delivered to the official mailing address for the licenses (the location where your licensed activities were authorized), and although you did not request this change in writing, the NRC initiated amendment actions to change the official mailing address of the license to your home address. This issue was discussed with you on multiple occasions, most recently during the February inspection of your facility. As of April 15, 2015, we have made an administrative change to the official mailing address of the above-listed licenses. You provided this address to us several years ago as a second address for mailing duplicate information. This address will be used in all future NRC correspondence. Enclosed with this letter are the amended licenses.

Copies of information for the Radiation Safety Office will continue to be mailed to his home address.

These amendments do not change the requirement to cease activities in accordance with the Order dated December 19, 2011. We expect to you decommission your facilities as described in our letters dated March 4, 2015 and April 21, 2015. We further expect the decommissioning to be completed no later than March 22, 2016.

Please review the enclosed documents carefully and be sure that you understand and fully implement all the conditions incorporated into the amended licenses. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region I Office, Licensing Assistance Team, (610) 337-5239, so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

An environmental assessment for these actions are not required, since the actions are categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(14).
