## General Comment

The transport of highly radioactive liquid nuclear waste from Chalk River, Ontario to Savannah, South Carolina is unprecedented and irresponsible. This activity requires a full Environmental Impact Statement to assess the worse case scenarios, and to consider options, such as the solification in Canada.

This should not proceed in the absence of that kind of scrutiny.
