1 SECY-88-298 is a final rule dealing with 10 CFR Part
2 62 entitled "Criteria and Procedures for Granting Emergency
3 Access to Non-Federal and Regional Low-Level Waste Disposal
4 Facilities."

5 The Commission is being asked to approve a new Part
6 62 to Title 10 of the Code of Regulations, which would
7 establish criteria and procedures to be used by NRC in
8 determining whether emergency access should be granted to
9 operating non-federal low-level radioactive waste disposal
10 facilities under the Low-Level Radioactive Waste Policy
11 Amendments Act of 1985.

12 All Commissioners have approved the final rule which
13 contains criteria and procedures.

14 Would you please affirm your votes?


