NRC STAFF RESPONSE TO BOARD REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REGARDING MR. CHAISSON'S STATUS

On May 19, 2015, the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board (Board) issued a Memorandum and Order (Requesting Additional Information Regarding Mr. Chaisson's Status), requesting the NRC Staff (Staff) to provide specific information regarding James Chaisson's apparent incarceration. Specifically, the Board requested that the staff obtain the following information: "(1) confirmation that Mr. Chaisson has been incarcerated; (2) the length of his sentence and his estimated date of release; and (3) how the staff and the Board might be able to contact Mr. Chaisson during any period of incarceration (e.g., a mailing address) besides sending information to his home address in Orem, Utah."¹

On May 19, 2015, Staff's counsel spoke with Katherine Peters, the Assistant District Attorney at the Salt Lake County District Attorney's Office responsible for Mr. Chaisson's criminal proceeding. Ms. Peters informed Staff's counsel that Mr. Chaisson had been sentenced on May 11, 2015 to a 30-day jail sentence and a 365-day monitoring period. Therefore, his expected date of release would be on or around June 10, 2015. With respect to contacting Mr. Chaisson during his period of incarceration, the Salt Lake County Metro Jail permits inmates to receive both regular mail and electronic mail (after setting up an account and
