Mr. Ramsey,

As a follow-up to my e-mail to you on May 14, I wish to request an extension of time for Idaho State University to reply to your letter of April to President Vailas, requesting our reconsideration of appointing the current department chair, Dr. Dunzik-Gougar, as the Reactor Administrator to replace me.

I have met with Mr. Xiaosong Yin, the program manager for our R-110 license, and he and I have agreed to a solution to the organizational issue so as to meet qualification requirements recommended by the ANS Standard. However, the solution has required a modification (an amendment) to the Technical Specification for the AGN-210 reactor. Consequently we need to follow the procedures for making an amendment. We will need approximately one more week from this date in order to clear all of the approvals (from the Reactor Safety Committee as well as the ISU administration).

Hence, I am requesting an extension on replying to your letter sent to us in April, an extension until June 1, 2015. .

Your favorable consideration of this request will be much appreciated.
