Could you please reply back to this email to confirm receipt?

This is in response to your termination and amendment requests dated February 24, 2015. The action appears to be a request to consolidate both Charleston Hospital, Inc. d/b/a Saint Francis Hospital and Herbert J. Thomas Memorial Hospital under one license with the name changing to Thomas Health Systems, and then terminating the Charleston Hospital license. In order to continue our review, please provide the following additional information:

1. By letter dated January 26, 2007 (ADAMS Accession Number ML070320759), the NRC was notified that Herbert J. Thomas Memorial Hospital Association, which owns Thomas Memorial Hospital, acquired 100% of the stock of Charleston Hospital, Inc. which owns and operates Saint Francis Hospital. Please confirm that Thomas Health Systems is the same entity as Herbert J. Thomas Memorial Hospital Association. If they are not the same entity, please provide documentation of any further change of ownership.
2. Please provide the name, title, and contact information of the management representative of Thomas Health Systems.
3. Please confirm if the name on the license should be Thomas Health System or Thomas Health Systems.
4. Please confirm how the name of each facility should appear on the license (i.e. Saint Francis Hospital and Thomas Memorial Hospital).
