Dear Mr. Viellenave:

By letter dated October 3, 2012, AUC LLC, submitted to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) an application for a source and byproduct materials license for the Reno Creek Project located in Campbell County, Wyoming. In order to approve a license application, NRC staff reviews the application for technical compliance with the Atomic Energy Act, as amended, and for related environmental effects in accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act.

Staff's technical review will be documented in a Safety Evaluation Report (SER). The staff is in the process of finalizing the SER for the Reno Creek Project. Enclosed is a copy of the draft license, which is preliminary in nature and for the purpose of initiating discussions necessary to finalize the SER. It should be noted that as the staff's review continues, this draft license is subject to change. Furthermore, this draft has not been subjected to NRC legal review. As such, disclosure of this draft license does not constitute a final licensing decision by the NRC.

Please review the draft license and provide written comments within 30 days of receipt of this letter. Comments can be provided via letter or email. The staff can also schedule a public meeting to discuss the draft license. Significant changes or deviations from the draft license may require additional staff review and may delay the final review schedule.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Agency Rules of Practice and Procedure," a copy of this letter will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records component of NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS).
