In that ALAB, the Appeal Board certified to the Commission its ruling that the environmental contention proffered by the intervenor New England Coalition on Nuclear Pollution and the Commonwealth of Massachusetts was not admissible in this proceeding.

All Commissioners have approved an Order attached to our memorandum of April 4, which returns the matter to the Appeal Board for further consideration in consistence with the guidance in that Order.
