I am responding to your letter dated April 22, 2015, which requested that the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) approve a new truck route designated as NRC Route No. 250 for transporting spent nuclear fuel from Byron Generating Station, Byron, IL to the Savannah River Site, near Aiken, SC.

The NRC has reviewed your application and concluded that the information satisfies the requirements of Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) Part 73.37. This letter constitutes approval of NRC Route No. 250 which will expire June 1, 2020.

The NRC expects your periodic review and update of the emergency phone numbers associated with this route. Changes to emergency contact numbers do not qualify as a route deviation or change.
