The Commission is being asked to approve a final rule which amends 10 CFR Part 2 to establish procedures to govern a high-level waste licensing proceeding, including the use of an electronic information management system known as the LSS Support System.

As detailed in the attached draft SRM, which is attached to our memorandum of 27 March, all Commissioners have approved the portions of the rule dealing with the LSS.

Chairman Zech, Carr and Rogers have also approved the procedural changes recommended by the negotiating committee. Commissioner Roberts and Curtiss have disapproved the non-LSS procedural changes to the rule and Commissioner Curtiss has


