24 motion for reconsideration of CLI-88-10, filed on
25 March 3rd by the Attorney General of Massachusetts.

1 The motion requests that the Commission reconsider the
2 decommissioning funding requirements for the Seabrook
3 Station and remand the issue of the low-level waste
4 generation and disposal to the Licensing Board for
5 litigation.

6 Chairman Zech, Commissioners Roberts, Carr,
7 Rogers and Curtiss have approved the order which
8 denies a motion. Would you please affirm your votes.

9 (Ayes.)

10 CHAIRMAN ZECH: Is there anything else to
11 come before us this afternoon?

12 SECRETARY CHILK: I have nothing else.

13 CHAIRMAN ZECH: If not, we stand adjourned.
