1 National Environmental Policy Act with respect to
2 geologic repositories for high level radioactive
3 waste.

4 In accordance with the Nuclear Waste Policy
5 Act of 1982 as amended, the rule provides for the
6 Commission to adopt, to the extent practicable, a
7 final environmental impact statement prepared by the
8 Department of Energy that accompanies the
9 recommendations of the President for repository
10 development.

11 The rule recognizes that the primary
12 responsibility for evaluating environmental impacts
13 lies with the Department of Energy; and, consistent
14 with this view, it sets out the standards and
15 procedures that would be used in determining whether
16 adoption of the Department's final environmental
17 impact statement is practicable.

18 All commissioners have the rule -- approved
19 the rule with the modifications attached to our June
20 7th memorandum.

21 May I ask you to affirm your votes please?

2 Unit 2.

3 In this paper the Commission is being asked
4 to act on an order responding to a June 5th, 1989
5 motion by the Philadelphia Electric Company requesting
6 clarification of the licensing status of the Limerick
7 Generating Station, Unit 2.

8 All commissioners have approved an order as
9 attached to our June 8th memorandum. In that order
10 the order states that, in order that the Commission be
11 -- Commission can consider the position of all the
12 parties properly, the order sets forth a schedule for
13 responses to the applicant's motion.

14 The intervenor, Limerick Ecology Action,
15 shall file by June 16th, 1989; the NRC staff by June
16 20th, 1989; and PECO shall file this reply by June the
17 23rd, 1989.

18 The order also directs that, pending the
19 resolution of PECO's motion, the NRC staff will not
20 issue any authorization for operation of Limerick Unit
21 2 beyond those steps necessary for fuel loading and
22 precriticality testing.


