Good Morning Megan,

Since the Seminole Tribe of Florida (STOF) will clearly not be able to provide comments regarding the draft EIS for the Turkey Point project until after our meeting with the Nuclear Regularity Commission (NRC) and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps), we are requesting a 90 days extension to our comment period. The standard 30 day review period ended on approximately April 13, 2015. The STOF has been requesting a meeting with the NRC for over a year and through no fault of the Tribe a meeting has never taken place. The requested extension would allow us until July 13, 2015 to review the documents, consult with the Corps and NRC, and to provide reasoned comments. Thank you for your help in this matter.
