4 gentlemen.

5 This is an affirmation session. We have two
6 items to come before us this morning.

7 Before I ask the Secretary to lead us
8 through the items for affirmation, do any of my fellow
9 Commissioners have any opening comments they would
10 like to make?

11 Mr. Secretary?

12 SECRETARY CHILK: One of the items, Mr.
13 Chairman, requires a Commission vote to hold on less
14 than one week's notice. The item is SECY-89-322, Motion
15 by Citizens for Fair Utility Regulation for a Stay of
16 Anticipated Low Power License at Comanche Peak Number
17 1.

18 Might I have that vote, please?

19 CHAIRMAN CARR: Aye.

20 COMMISSIONER ROBERTS: Aye.

21 COMMISSIONER CURTISS: Aye.

22 SECRETARY CHILK: Thank you.

23 Doctor Bates will read the affirmation.

24 DOCTOR BATES: Mr. Chairman, the first item
25 is SECY-89-312, Decision on Massachusetts Attorney

1 General's Petition for a Rule Waiver Certified ALAB-
2 920.

3 The Commission is being asked to decide, in
4 the case of the Seabrook Station, whether to waive the
5 Commission's financial qualification rules.

6 All Commissioners have approved an order,
7 which was circulated earlier this morning, which finds
8 that the circumstances in this case do not undercut
9 the assurance of the availability from governmental
10 rate-setters of a source of funds adequate for safe
11 operation pursuant to a full power license. Nor has
12 the Commission been shown any other significant link
13 between Applicant's financial situation and a safety
14 problem. Accordingly, the Commission does not grant
15 the waiver sought.

16 May I have an affirmation of your votes?

17 CHAIRMAN CARR: Aye.

18 COMMISSIONER ROBERTS: Aye.

19 COMMISSIONER CURTISS: Aye.

20 DOCTOR BATES: The second item, SECY-89-322,
21 Motion by Citizens for Fair Utility Regulation for a
22 Stay of the Anticipated Low Power License at Comanche
23 Peak Unit 1.

24 The Commission is being asked to respond to
25 a motion by CFUR for a stay of issuance of the low

1 power license for Comanche Peak Unit 1.

2 Chairman Carr and Commissioners Roberts and
3 Curtiss have approved an order which denies the
4 requested stay and refers CFUR's assertions that there
5 are possible safety hazards associated with the low
6 power operation to the NRC staff for appropriate
7 resolution in accordance with the Commission's
8 procedures for handling allegations.

9 Commissioner Rogers is on travel and he's
10 unavailable to participate in the matter.

11 Will you affirm your votes?

12 CHAIRMAN CARR: Aye.

13 COMMISSIONER ROBERTS: Aye.

14 COMMISSIONER CURTISS: Aye.

15 CHAIRMAN CARR: Is there anything else to
16 come before us today?

17 SECRETARY CHILK: We have nothing, sir.

18 CHAIRMAN CARR: If not, we stand adjourned.

20 entitled matter was adjourned.)


