JOINT REPORT OF SETTLEMENT NEGOTIATIONS

At the prehearing conference held on August 27, 1997, in the above-captioned proceeding, the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board (Board) directed the parties to report to the Board on September 10, 1997, as to whether 1) the parties have been able to reach settlement; 2) if not, how far the distance is apart and any suggestions on closing that distance; or 3) whether settlement is unlikely. Tr. at 48-49.

The parties have not been able to reach settlement. The Staff believes that settlement discussions have not been productive and it is unlikely that further discussions will be productive. The Licensee believes that a meaningful settlement can be reached.


