US Nuclear Regulatory Commission

Please do not approve the expansion of the nuclear power plant at Turkey Point. My biggest concern is that Turkey point, like Fukushima, could be affected by sea level rise. In addition, the existing Turkey point units already have problems with cooling its units. FPL will need to use Florida's natural aquifer to cool its units, should it run out of treated waste water. Neither of these concerns are addressed in the application submitted to your agency. I believe you should do the right thing and not approve the Turkey Point plant expansion.
