Advanced Power Reactor (APR)-1400 Design Certifications Application

On May 20, 2015, as a result of a non-competitive solicitation, cost-reimbursement interagency agreement number NRC-HQ-25-15-T-0005 was issued to Brookhaven National Laboratory in Upton, New York. The objective of this task order is to obtain technical expertise to assist the NRC staff in evaluating and resolving complex technical issues related to Sections 3.7, 3.8, 9.1.2, 14.3.2, 19.1.5.1, and 19.2.4 of the Advanced Power Reactor (APR-1400) application, including any technical reports corresponding to the application. The period of performance is from May 20, 2015, through January 31, 2019. The total cost ceiling is \$1,061,295.
