SUBJECT: CLARIFICATION OF INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT REGARDING
CLASSIFICATION OF INFORMATION AT USEC INC. LEAD CASCADE AND
AMERICAN CENTRIFUGE PLANT URANIUM ENRICHMENT FACILITIES – J5712

Dear Ms. DiSomma:

On September 24, 2012, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) entered into an interagency agreement (NRC-HQ-50-12-I-002) entitled "Classification of Information at the USEC Inc. Lead Cascade and American Centrifuge Plant Uranium Enrichment Facilities." On September 30, 2014, as part of the terms associated with a bankruptcy filing, USEC Inc. changed its name to Centrus Energy Corp. This action did not affect the NRC licenses, which names American Centrifuge Operating, LLC, as the licensee.

The referenced name change does not alter the scope of work or technical details associated with NRC-HQ-50-12-I-002; therefore, the NRC does not intend to modify any of the contractual documentation. The intent of this letter is to notify the DOE of the referenced name change and provide confirmation that the existing scope of work (SOW) of NRC-HQ-50-12-I-002 remains unchanged. Work performed by DOE under the existing SOW to support Centrus Energy Corp. should continue to be billed through the Intra-Government Payment and Collection system via NRC-HQ-50-12-I-002 (NRC budget code 50-38-4-149-J5712).
