

Authorized users are trained in accordance with Item 12.B., of license amendment 21. Workers handling sources that expose individuals to "radiation area" or "high radiation area" levels will receive specialized training from a Certified Health Physicist (CHP) or a National Registry of Radiation Protection Technician (NRRPT). Alternatively, a worker may receive training from an individual designated by the DTRA/SCC-WMD RSO with sufficient competencies to perform the training for each type and quantity of material used. Training documentation will be maintained.
