CHAIRMAN SELIN: Ladies and gentlemen, we have an affirmation session with one item to come before us this afternoon.

Mr. Hoyle, would you lead us through it, please?

MR. HOYLE: Commissioners, Mr. Chairman, the item is SECY-94-135, A Final Rule on Timeliness in Decommissioning of Materials Facilities.

The Commission is being asked to approve the issuance of a final rule to require timely decontamination and decommissioning by nuclear material licensees. The amendments establish specific time periods for decommissioning unused portions of operating nuclear materials facilities and for decommissioning the entire site upon termination of operations.

The Chairman and Commissioners Rogers and Remick have approved the rule. Commissioner de Planque has disapproved publication of the rule at this time. She would prefer to wait until after receipt of comments on the proposed radiological criteria for decommissioning rule.

I'd ask you to affirm your votes, please.
