11 final amendments to 10 CFR Part 73, to modify the
12 design basis threat to require reactor licensees to
13 install vehicle control measures, including vehicle
14 barrier systems, to protect against the malevolent use
15 of a land vehicle.

16 All Commissioners have approved the final
17 rule as proposed by the staff with the exception of
18 certain specific provisions contained in the
19 safeguards document.

20 I ask you to affirm your votes at this
21 time.
