That order directed the staff to first promptly release to Mr. Allen Mosbaugh and the Georgia Power easy-to-separate Company all of the information contained in the Office of Investigations Report on alleged false statements to the NRC by GPC officials on diesel generator testing; and secondly, release on April the 4th the remainder of the Office of Investigation's report, subject to protective order.

All Commissioners have approved an order that directs the staff, the NRC staff, first to make available to the parties within seven days for inspection and copying the documents and material identified in the list of exhibits to the OI report; and second, at the time of issuance of an enforcement
