DR. BATES: Commissioners, Mr. Chairman. The Commission is being asked today to approve SECY-95-067 a final amendment to the nuclear power plant license renewal rule. The amendment revises the current rule to establish greater credit for existing license programs, licensee programs, and the license renewal process. It resolves ambiguities between the current statement of consideration and the current rule and establishes a more efficient statement of predictable license renewal process. The Chairman and Commissioners Rogers and de Planque have approved the rule with modifications as directed in the staff requirements memo that we circulated in draft form
