- SECY papers completed for emergency preparedness (EP) decommissioning exemptions at four sites
- 27 HAB exercises inspected and lessons learned completed during the process
- Completed all communication and staffing submittals for the Fukushima Near Term Task Force rulemaking efforts
- Completed and issued Fermi 2 combined license
- Small modular reactor EP - Commission Paper

Priorities



- Maintain readiness of the response organization and headquarters operations center
- Enhance preparedness and response guidance, ensuring clear expectations with stakeholders, and compatibility with broader all-hazards approaches; especially for NUREG-0654 revisions, decommissioning emergency preparedness guidance, and incident response manual chapters/procedures
- Prepare for and conduct the full-federal, whole community exercise – Southern Exposure 2015



Vermont Yankee

Emergency Response Data System (ERDS)

- Appendix E to Part 50 (Section VI.2)
 - Not required if permanently or indefinitely shut down
 - Removal under 50.54(q)
- NRC Memorandum of Understanding with States
 - Provide ERDS feed in support of protective action decisionmaking

NUREG-0654/FEMA-REP-1, Table B-1

- Planning Basis
 - No single specific accident sequence
- Initial accident response in key functional areas
 - On-Shift Staffing
- Timely augmentation of response capabilities
 - 30 and 60 minute responders

ERO Augmentation Submittals



- NSIR/DPR-ISG-01
 - Provides accident or event scenarios to be used in on-shift staffing analysis
- NEI 10-05
 - No competing priorities (on-shift staffing)
 - Does not provide a justification for timing extension or elimination of <u>function/capability</u>
- Opportunity:
 - Proposed Revision 2 to NUREG/FEMA-REP-1

Emergency Plan Submittals



- Re-Baselining or Combining into Common (Fleet) Emergency Plan
 - Regulatory Basis for Review?
 - Possible Unintended Consequences
 - Consideration of Existing License Commitments
 - Review Against Current Standards/Guidance





EP Licensing: SMR Policy Issues



- "Right Sized" Emergency Preparedness Program
- NEI White Paper
 - December 23, 2013-White Paper on EPZ sizing methodology provided to the NRC
 - April 8, 2014-NEI and NRC held public meeting to exchange ideas and receive public comments
- TVA Early Site Permit Application for SMRs
 - May 5, 2015 public meeting, TVA discussed intent to propose both a site boundary and 2-mile EPZ to be bounding for all SMR designs
- NRC staff has prepared a policy paper for Commission decision on SMR EP
 - Due to Commission June 3 2015



WebEOC



- The NRC uses WebEOC for coordinating event information, task tracking, and team management
- Primarily used internally within NRC; sharing through WebFusion
 - Utilities
 - INPO 13-10
 - NRC connection through INPO
 - State/Local
 - Working with CRCPD to promote consistency
 - Federal

RASCAL v4.3.1



- Newest minor revision released in February 2015
 - Fixes minor bugs
 - Addresses default 2-hour spent fuel fire time assumption
- Radiation Protection Computer Code Analysis and Maintenance Program (RAMP)
 - Requires annual membership or single purchase for utilities
