In NRC Form 314 dated March 16, 2015, you contacted the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and indicated that you wished to terminate your NRC radioactive material license. You were listed as the designated contact person regarding this request.

In your request, you confirmed that all activities authorized under NRC License No. 21-26008-01 have ceased, and all radioactive materials procured and/or possessed by the licensee under this license number were transferred to another NRC licensee on March 12, 2015. Based on its review, the staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from the Shiawassee County Road Commission facilities and residual radioactive material attributable to licensed activities does not exceed current NRC criteria.

Based on these conclusions no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required. Your facility is suitable for unrestricted use and NRC license number 21-26008-01 is hereby terminated.
