In response to Commission requirements, staff is taking action to:


- Ensure licensees address the reevaluated flood hazard levels within mitigating strategies
- Enhance Phase 1 guidance and develop
 Phase 2 guidance




SRM-COMSECY-14-0037

- Action plan largely complete
 - Graded approach with focus on areas with most potential safety benefit
 - Improve efficiency and maintain appropriate technical rigor
 - Goal: NRC to provide feedback on the hazard by the end of 2015
 - Public meetings: May 21 & June 17
 - Application to seismic activities

Recommendation 2.1 – Proposed Flooding Closure Plan






Guidance Development

- Several guidance documents are integral to the plan:
 - NEI 12-06, FLEX implementation guidance
 - Appendix G Flooding
 - Appendix H Seismic
 - To be endorsed by revising JLD-ISG-2012-01
 - DG-1301, guidance for implementing the rule
 - To incorporate NEI 12-06, Appendices G&H
 - NEI screening and IA clarification guidance
 - Additional evaluations

Key Success Milestones

- Schedules for:
 - Screening/IA guidance (Dec 2015)
 - Implementation of MS assessment/upgrades (Dec 2016)
 - Focused evaluations (Dec 2016)
 - Integrated assessments (Dec 2017)

- <u>Direct Inspection</u> by Vendor Inspection Center of Excellence
- Enforcement
 - Primary: Notices of Nonconformance to vendor
 - Secondary: Issue violations to individual licensees
