24	intervenors' petition for review and permitting the state of
25	Oklahoma to file a brief amicus curiae. I ask you to affirm

- decommissioning activities which were prohibited prior to
- 14 approval of a decommissioning plan. All limitations
- regarding the licensee's conduct of decommissioning
- 16 activities remain in effect until further order of the
- 17 Commission.
- I ask you to affirm your votes.
