9	COMMISSIONER ROGERS: No, thank you.
10	CHAIRMAN JACKSON: If not, Mr. Hoyle, you may
11	proceed.
12	MR. HOYLE: Madame Chairman, we have one item for
13	affirmation today. It is SECY-95-181. In this paper the
14	Commission is being asked to approve publication of final
15	amendments to 10 CFR Part 50, Appendix J, to adopt
16	performance oriented and risk based approaches to
17	containment leakage testing.
18	This rule is being approved today by the Chairman
19	under delegated authority voted by the Commission as
20	authorized by the NRC Reorganization Plan Number One of
21	1980. This decision has been made after consultation with
22	Commissioner Rogers.
23	Chairman Jackson has stated her approval of the
24	rule. Commissioner Rogers has also stated his agreement
25	with this rule. In reaching this decision, the Commission

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expects that there should be virtually no need for schedule 1 driven exemptions for licensees that choose to go to a ten 2 year test interval period. This rule will become effective 3 30 days after publication in the Federal Register. 4 May I ask you to affirm your votes on this final 5 6 rule? 7 COMMISSIONER ROGERS: Aye. CHAIRMAN JACKSON: I do. 8 MR. HOYLE: Thank you. 9 CHAIRMAN JACKSON: Is there anything else to come 10 11 before us today? MR.
