The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) is publishing the following document in the *Federal Register*.

- Title: Cyber Security Event Notifications [RIN 3150-AJ37; NRC-2014-0036].
- Description of the rule: This final rule amends Part 73 of Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations (10 CFR), "Physical Protection of Plants and Materials," by adopting new cyber security event notification requirements.
- This action is necessary because cyber security event notification requirements were not previously included in the rule that established the NRC's cyber security regulations.
- Adding this new requirement will contribute to the NRC's analysis of the reliability and effectiveness of licensees' cyber security programs.
- Dates: The effective date of this final rule is 30 days after publication. The compliance date of this final rule is 180 days after publication.
- This is not a major rule as defined by the Congressional Review Act.
