I approve the staff's request to discontinue the rulemaking activity that would require work hour controls for nuclear power plant personnel who perform independent quality control and quality verification (QC/QV) activities. The staff has determined that in recent years the number of such workers has significantly declined, and these functions have increasingly been folded into maintenance organizations, which are subject to the work hour controls of the fitness for duty program. As a result, the proposed rulemaking provisions would not result in a substantial increase in the overall protection of the public health and safety or the common defense and security. Accordingly the staff should publish a notice of withdrawal of the regulatory basis and preliminary proposed rule language in the <i>Federal Register</i> to inform the public that the agency is no longer pursuing this rulemaking activities and the three petitions for rulemaking that were also to have been considered will be addressed in a separate action. In addition, I delegate the signature authority to the Executive Director for Operations for the <i>Federal Register</i> notice withdrawing the rulemaking. SIGNATURE July 2015 DATE
