Most agencies with criminal law enforcement responsibilities follow the approach of the FBI, which is generally to respond to FOIA requests for records concerning other individuals by refusing to confirm or deny whether such records exist. Such a response is necessary because members of the public may draw adverse inferences from the mere fact that an individual is mentioned in the files of a criminal law enforcement agency.¹

This is NRC's final decision.
