(Proposed Revision 2 of Regulatory Guide 5.62)

REPORTING OF SAFEGUARDS EVENTS

Ref. section II.(b) of Appendix G (Reportable Safeguards Events) to 10 CFR 73; specifically...

"II. Events to be recorded within 24 hours of discovery in the safeguards event log.

(b) Any other threatened, attempted, or committed act not previously defined in appendix G with the potential for reducing the effectiveness of the safeguards system below that committed to in a licensed physical security or contingency plan or the actual condition of such reduction in effectiveness."

There appears to be two distinct criteria contained within this section. The first part of the section clearly addresses a specific 'act' (whether threatened, attempted, or committed), which has the potential for reducing the effectiveness of the safeguards system below that committed to in a licensed physical security or contingency plan.

However, the second part of the section ("...or the actual condition of such reduction in effectiveness...") is unclear.

Does this latter part mean that any deviation from a licensee's Security/Contingency Plan should be logged?

Or, is it linked to an 'act' in some way (as is the case in the first part of the section)?
