Pursuant to 10CFR, §50.59, please find attached a proposed revision to the Oconee Nuclear Station Technical Specifications. The revision will allow Duke Power Company to proceed with monitoring and reporting aspects of our waste disposal program monitoring under our proposed "Appendix I" program until the Staff completed its review of the program in its entirety. The proposed change includes substituting revised Notes 5 and 6 in Table 4.1-3 separating the current Note 5 into liquid (5) and gaseous (6) portions and also changing the references thereto. The proposal also deletes the reporting requirement for I-135 in Section 6.6.1.4(2)(a) and Table 6.6-1 Section II(9).

The first change is intended to simply clarify the Table in a manner consistent with the proposed Appendix I program. The second change, deletion of I-135 from the reporting requirements is also consistent with NUREG-0133 and is considered to be appropriate based on the environmental impact of the nuclide.

These requests are made because our records are kept on an annual basis beginning on January 1. Therefore, on January 1, 1980 we began keeping records based on the anticipated Appendix I program and we are now having to duplicate work to maintain the old records for I-135. This is an unnecessary expenditure of revenue, considering the lack of any benefit.

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
