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SAFETY EVALUATION REPORT

SUMMARY

By letter dated July 15, 2015, *EnergySolutions* requested renewal of Certificate of Compliance No. 9204 for the Model No. 10-160B package. *EnergySolutions* did not request any changes to the design, operating procedures, acceptance tests, and maintenance program of the package. The Certificate has been renewed for a five year term.

EVALUATION

EnergySolutions requested renewal of Certificate of Compliance No. 9204 for the Model No. 10-160B package by letter dated July 15, 2015. No changes in the package design, operating procedures, acceptance tests and maintenance program or contents of the package were requested. The staff reviewed the documents referenced in the certificate of compliance, Revision No. 21, and determined that the required documentation was available and complete.

The following revisions to the certificate have been made:

Condition No. 14 was modified to change the expiration date of the certificate to October 31, 2020.

CONCLUSION

The certificate has been renewed for a five year term that expires on October 31, 2020. This change does not affect the ability of the package to meet the requirements of 10 CFR Part 71.
