**SUBJECT: NRC APPROVAL OF WALTER KIDDE PORTABLE EQUIPMENT, INC.,
FOR WITHHOLDING INFORMATION FROM PUBLIC DISCLOSURE**

Dear Mr. Keough:

Walter Kidde Portable Equipment, Inc., ("Kidde") submitted an affidavit dated August 12, 2015, requesting that the information on pages 22, 23, 25 and 26 of its Amendment Request of that date be withheld from public disclosure pursuant to Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations (10CFR) 2.390.

The affidavit stated that the submitted information should be considered exempt from mandatory public disclosure for the following reasons: (1) the information has not been made available to the public, (2) the information constitutes trade secrets and confidential commercial information, and (3) public disclosure of the information is highly likely to cause substantial harm to the company.

We have reviewed your application and the material in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 2.390 and, on the basis of your statements, have determined that the submitted information sought to be withheld contains proprietary commercial information and should be withheld from public disclosure.

Therefore, pages 22, 23, 25 and 26 of the application dated August 20, 2015, will be withheld from public disclosure pursuant to 10 CFR 2.390(b)(5) and Section 103(b) of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended. Withholding from public inspection shall not affect the right, if any, of persons properly and directly concerned to inspect the documents.

If the basis for withholding this information from public inspection should change in the future such that the information could then be made available for public inspection, you should promptly notify the NRC. You also should understand that the NRC may have cause to review this determination in the future, for example, if the scope of a Freedom of Information Act request includes your information. In all review situations, if the NRC makes a determination adverse to the above, you will be notified of the date of public disclosure, in advance which will be a reasonable time thereafter.
