SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF TELEPHONE CALL WITH THE CITY OF JANESVILLE
ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT

On July 7, 2015, U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff spoke with Gale Price, City of Janesville Economic Development Director, to discuss the NRC's environmental review of an application submitted by SHINE Medical Technologies, Inc. (SHINE) for a construction permit for a facility to produce radioisotopes. Specifically, the NRC asked Mr. Price whether any additional businesses or projects expressed interest in constructing or operating within TIF Districts No. 34 and No. 35. Mr. Price explained that a large distribution center has expressed interest in a plot of land on TIF District No. 35. Mr. Price further explained that the owners of the distribution center are currently deciding among at least three locations where to site the facility. If the TIF District No. 35 site were to be selected, the distribution center would be constructed and operated on a 124-acre (9.7-hectare) parcel of land, and no radiological material would be housed within the facility. Associated activities could include approximately 100 truck trips per day. Final site selection is expected to occur in the 4th quarter of calendar year 2015. Construction would begin in late 2015, followed by operations beginning in 2016. Mr. Price was unaware of any additional proposed industrial or commercial projects within TIF Districts No. 34 and 35 or in their immediate vicinity.
