To Whom It May Concern:

This Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA") (5 U.S.C. § 552) request seeks the following listed documents. The request is very specific and the time frame for responsive documents is limited to January 1, 2015, to the present, to expedite your response.

In NRC's June 2015 Monthly Status Report on Activities relating to the Yucca Mountain Licensing Proceeding ("Report"), at page 2, the following statement is made:

On June 10-11, the NRC staff visited selected locations in the Yucca Mountain area to support the staff's analysis in the EIS supplement of specific impacts on groundwater downstream from the proposed repository site. The staff also visited the repository site at Yucca Mountain, including the portals to the underground Exploratory Studies Facility and the ridge crest.

In connection with the NRC Staff visit on June 10-11, the following documents are requested:

1. All documents (including but not limited to all NRC Staff trip reports) identifying the "selected locations" in "the Yucca Mountain area" visited by NRC Staff.
2. All documents generated by any member of NRC Staff during or after the visits (referred to in No. 1 above) reflecting any factual information collected, any analyses performed, and any conclusions reached, as a consequence of such visits.


3. All documents identifying or discussing the anticipated or budgeted or actual costs incurred by NRC or Staff in conducting the visits referred to in No. 1 above.
4. All documents (including but not limited to all NRC Staff trip reports) identifying the specific locations of "the repository site at Yucca Mountain" also visited by NRC Staff, according to the quoted portion of NRC's June 2015 Report.
5. All documents generated by any member of NRC Staff during or after the visits (referred to in No. 4 above) reflecting any factual information collected, any analyses performed, and any conclusions reached, as a consequence of such visits.
6. All documents identifying or discussing the anticipated or budgeted or actual costs incurred by NRC or Staff in conducting the visits referred to in No. 4 above.
7. Documents (including but not limited to sign-in sheets) sufficient to identify all attendees who took part in any of the visits referred to in No. 1 or No. 4 above and their respective organizational affiliations.

This request is made on behalf of the State of Nevada.

The requesting party is willing to pay up to a total amount of \$1,000 for search time and document copying costs without the necessity for further approval. The requesting party has specifically made this request as narrow as possible in order to facilitate expeditious and timely response by NRC.
