SUBJECT: NUCLEAR REGULATORY COMMISSION PLANNED MONITORING
ACTIVITIES FOR F AND H-AREA TANK FARMS AT THE SAVANNAH
RIVER SITE

The enclosed document describes the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC) planned activities in carrying out its responsibilities for monitoring the U.S. Department of Energy's (DOE) waste disposal activities at the F and H Area Tank Farms at the Savannah River Site in accordance with requirements contained in the Ronald W. Reagan National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2005. The monitoring plan is an update to a monitoring plan for F-Area Tank Farm completed in January 2013 (ADAMS Accession No, ML12212A192).

As you know, the staff developed a Technical Evaluation Report (TER) for the F-Area Tank Farm Facility in October 2011 (ADAMS Accession No. ML112371751) and a TER for H-Area Tank Farm in June 2014 (Adams Accession No. 14094A496) as part of the NRC consultation with DOE in its waste determinations for the tank farms. In the TER, the staff identified specific recommendations that staff believed would enhance DOE's likelihood of compliance with the performance objectives in Subpart C, 10 CFR Part 61. In the enclosed monitoring plan, prepared in consultation with the State of South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control, the staff identifies specific areas associated with these recommendations that it intends to monitor in assessing DOE's compliance with the performance objectives. The document describes what the staff intends to do in each of these areas, as well as other activities that will be performed to allow a complete assessment of compliance of all four performance objectives. In finalizing this document, the staff considered comments and input from the NRC Office of the General Counsel.
