Dear Sir:

I am writing in response to your request for voluntary reporting of additional occupational radiation exposure data per the subject NRC Generic Letter 94-04. The letter requests voluntary submittal of occupational radiation exposure data for certain employees for whom termination reports were not required prior to the implementation of new 10CFR20. The information will be used to update the Radiation Exposure Information Reporting System (REIRS) database, which is the basis for Nureg-0713, Occupational Radiation Exposure at Commercial Nuclear Power Reactors and Other Facilities. Duke Power Company has reviewed your request for information and has determined it will be mutually beneficial for us to comply. We would like to inform you that we will be responding for all three of our sites as follows:

Due to the magnitude of information you have requested, and the number of sites we must report for, it will take more than the requested 180 days to complete. We have estimated it will take approximately 18 months to fully complete your request. In order to simplify management of this large quantity of data, and provide you with information in the earliest possible timeframe, we propose to send the information in 4 batches; approximately 1 every 4 months.
