

The NRC provided written approval on April 10, 1995 for the Oconee Nuclear Site submittal to change the emergency classification scheme from NUREG 0654 to the guidance provided by NUMARC /NESP-007, Revision 2. Training has been completed for the emergency response organization and the new scheme will go into effect on November 1, 1995.

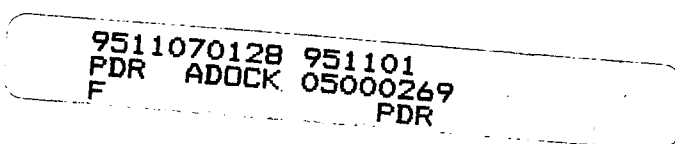
Since approval was received from the NRC, several changes have been made to the Basis Document as a result of additional review by Emergency Planning. These changes do not change the intent of the emergency classification; the changes were made to clarify the basis for the emergency action level for Operations personnel. Therefore, prior approval was not requested.

The changes are clearly marked on the attached pages of the Basis Document. Enclosure 1 provides a detailed statement concerning each change and also clearly shows that the changes are within the guidelines of the NUMARC/NESP-007 document.
