Enclosed is a copy of the final exercise report for the May 10, 1994, partial-participation plume exposure pathway exercise of the offsite radiological emergency response plans site-specific to the Oconee Nuclear Station. This report addresses the evaluation of the plans and preparedness for the State of South Carolina portions of the 10-mile Emergency Planning Zone. The State of South Carolina; risk counties of Oconee and Pickens and host counties of Anderson and Greenville participated in this exercise. The final exercise report was prepared by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Region IV staff. Copies of this report will be forwarded to the State of South Carolina and FEMA Headquarters by my staff.


There were no Deficiencies identified during the May 10, 1994, exercise. There was, however, one Area Requiring Corrective Action (ARCA) identified during this exercise. Region IV staff will coordinate with the State of South Carolina to correct the ARCA on or before the next scheduled biennial exercise.

Based on the results of the May 10, 1994, exercise, the offsite radiological emergency response plans and preparedness for the State of South Carolina and the affected local jurisdictions site-specific to the Oconee Nuclear Station can be implemented and are adequate to provide reasonable assurance that appropriate measures can be taken offsite to protect the health and safety of the public in the event of a radiological emergency at the site. The Title 44 CFR, Part 350, approval of the State of South Carolina offsite radiological emergency response plans and preparedness site-specific to Oconee Nuclear Station granted on February 23, 1983, will remain in effect.
