
Dear Sir:

By letter dated July 30, 1996, Duke Power committed to submit proposed Technical Specifications, by September 30, 1996, to allow the implementation of a random tendon selection process in accordance with Regulatory Guide 1.35. The purpose of specifying a submittal date for the revised Technical Specifications was to allow sufficient time for completion of NRC review to support the upcoming Unit 1 refueling outage in April, 1997.

Per discussion with your staff in a phone conversation on September 18, 1996, extension of the proposed Technical Specification submittal date to October 30, 1996, was determined to be acceptable. Since the basis for the committed submittal date was to allow for an adequate staff review period, it is concluded that a one-month extension of this date will not impact the health and safety of the public.
