Your letter of February 8, 1985, regarding possible groundwater contamination at the Duke Power Company near Keowee Key, South Carolina, was forwarded to me for response.

The Duke Power Company facility referred to in your letter is the Oconee Nuclear Station, a three-unit nuclear power plant. Groundwater concerns associated with the plant would most likely be due to an accidental release of radioactive contaminants. The U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission is charged with the authority to regulate and control the release of radioactive contaminants to the environment. Therefore, by copy of this letter, I am forwarding your inquiry to that office for response.



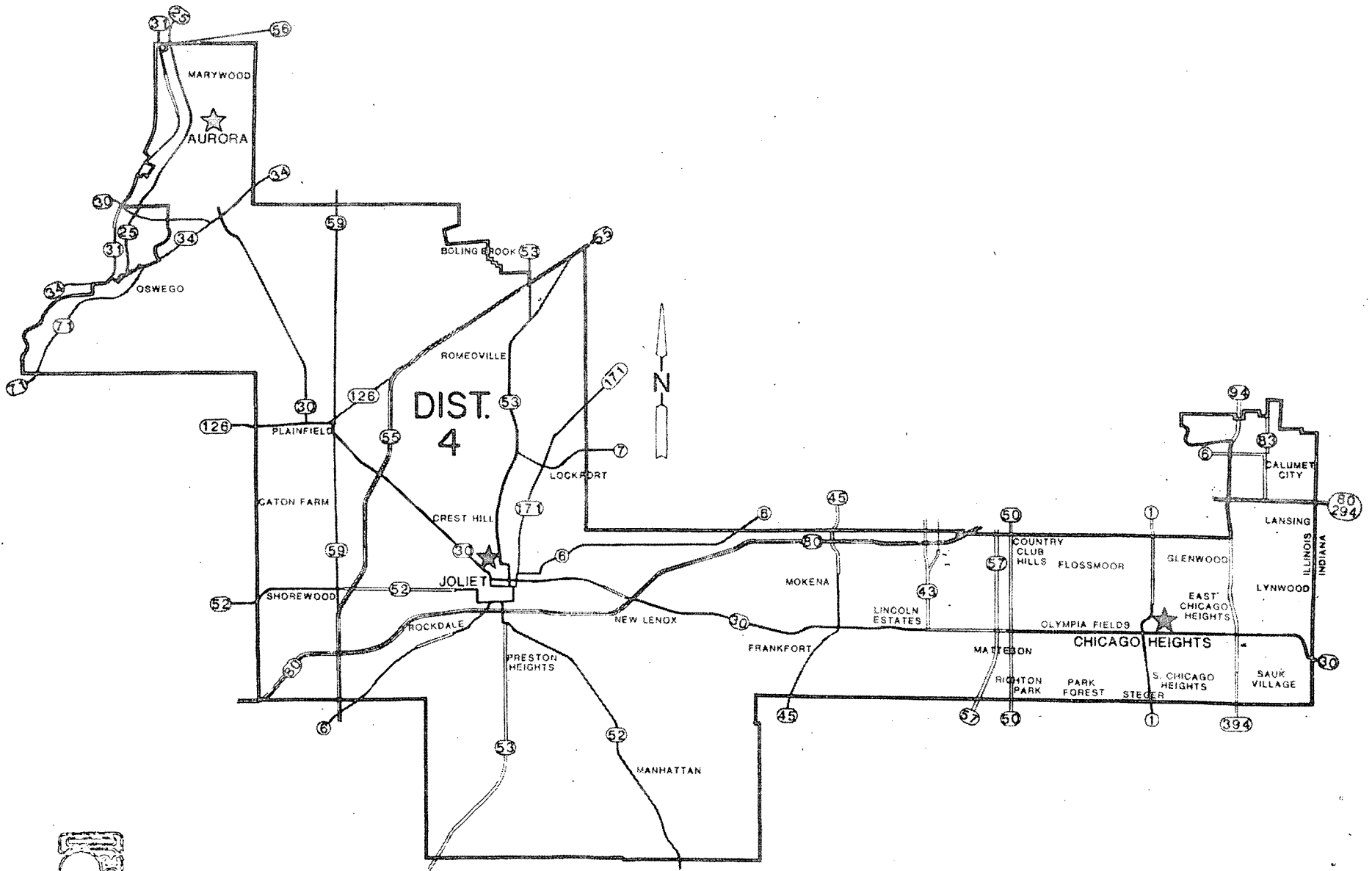
