As requested by Reference (A), which was received on February 23, 1981, Duke Power Company has performed a review of the items of concern identified in the Staff's evaluation of Reference (B).

Duke Power's review considered the identified potential equipment deficiencies, including their ramifications. This review has shown that in some instances, qualification data either was inadvertently omitted from Reference (B) or has only become available since the submittal of Reference (B). In other instances, qualification data was provided in Reference (B) which Duke Power considers valid, but which the Staff has identified as potentially deficient. In these instances, further clarification by the Staff is needed. For some equipment, Duke is performing testing to verify qualification; however, this equipment is expected to meet the qualification criteria based upon an engineering assessment of the equipment and its applications. Finally, some equipment will be replaced due to the unavailability of sufficient qualification documentation. The failure modes of this equipment have been considered during this review to assure that safety-related functions will not be degraded.

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




